Bilingual Ukrainian Catholic Parent Society (BUCPS) information:

Pysanky are traditionally made during Holy Week, the last week of Lent. History tells us that each region, village, and almost every family in Ukraine had its own special ritual, its own symbols, meanings and secret formulas for dyeing eggs. These customs were preserved faithfully and passed down through the generations. The practice of decorating pysanky was observed with greatest care, and a pysanka, after receiving the Easter blessing, was held to have great powers.

The students really look forward to and enjoy this annual activity. We appreciate that due to the pandemic, this experience may be a bit different this year at each of our three schools. To support the continuation of this tradition at home, the BUCPS Executive has packaged 50 Pysanka Starter Kits that we will be selling for \$20/each (see attached picture). Each kit includes: 1 medium tip wooden kistka, 1 single sheet of natural beeswax and 6 dyes (Yellow, Orange, Scarlet, Lt. Blue, Lt. Green, Black). We only have 50 available and they are first come first serve!

*** Please include in the Memo/Message of the e-transfer the students name, grade and teacher so the kits can be delivered to their classroom.

As there are only 50 kits this year, there will be a limit of 3 kits per family. ***

Delivery to schools will be the beginning of the week of March 22-26th, ensuring students can bring home by the end of that week.
