Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! We look forward to sharing in your child's faith and learning journeys at St. Nicholas. We have a team of faithful, professional and dedicated educators ready to guide and support your child this year.

Last Friday, information was sent outlining Elk Island Catholic Schools Year Plan. EICS is looking forward to welcoming



students and staff back to school and to the resumption of school activities. On August 13th, the Alberta government shared the 2021-2022 School Year Plan with stakeholders.

Our 2021-2022 School Plan will support schools in reducing the risk of transmission of illnesses and maintain a safe and healthy environment for our students and staff. EICS is committed to maintaining for the start of the 2021/2022 school year:

- Mandatory masks on the school bus
- Masks are strongly recommended in common areas of the school for students and staff
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting
- Regularly scheduled deep cleaning when students are not present
- Enhanced cleaning protocol with healthcare grade system that kills human coronavirus
- Stay-at-home policy for any students or staff exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19
- Physical distancing maximization within the confines of a classroom
- Hand hygiene/respiratory etiquette
- Daily screening following the Alberta Health Daily Checklist

Please note:

- Parents/visitors are permitted to enter the school provided there is a valid reason (ie. volunteering). Parents/volunteers are to make arrangements with their child's homeroom teacher or office staff prior to entering the school.
- All parents/volunteers are required to wear masks while in our schools
- Gatherings outside of classrooms or hallways are not to occur

In addition to these district protocols, St. Nicholas will be cohorting classes for recesses (to be reviewed on September 27th).

EICS will review our plan on September 27th, in accordance with the Chief Medical Officer of Health's scheduled update. The health, safety and well-being of our students and staff will

Wednesday, September 1

Staggered entry - For students with last names A-M

Friday, September 3
