details about classroom projects/activities that will be supporting this school in Ukraine. I would also like to acknowledge Harper Duke (grade 2 student in Pani Baugh's class) who, with the help of her classmates, raised over \$400 by accepting donations for their blue/yellow bracelets they made. These donations will be added to our school total. Well done grade 2 students!
