## Information

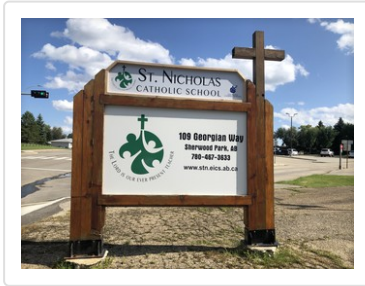
