Please join me in welcoming Ms. Lesoway to our staff. Ms. Lesoway will be teaching the grade 1 Ukrainian class, as Mrs. Dziwenko is off on maternity leave.

As part of the Ukrainian Christmas tradition, the students and



staff of St. Nicholas will take part in the Feast of Jordan - Epiphany. The celebration will take place on Thursday, January 19th at 1:00pm at St. Sophia's Ukrainian Catholic church. This celebration commemorates the revelation of the Holy Trinity as well as the baptism of Christ in the river Jordan by St. John the Baptist. On this day, it is the custom to bless water. In Ukraine, this blessing was held outside at a local body of water such as a river or lake. The men in the community would build a large cross of ice near where the water was blessed. During the ceremony, three special candles are immersed in the water; this is to remind us that through Christ's baptism our sins are forgiven. After the ceremony, the people take some of the blessed water to keep in their homes during the coming year. Students are asked to wear their Sunday best and the Ukrainian bilingual students Ukrainian attire that afternoon. On Thursday, January 19th, we will be leaving school at 12:30pm and returning at approximately 2:45pm. We are looking for parent volunteers to assist in pouring the blessed water (from the Feast of Jordan celebration) into the containers. Each student will receive a small bottle of blessed water to take home. If you would like to help, please let your child's teacher know (via email). Parent volunteers will meet in the staffroom at St. Nicholas school on Friday, January 20 at 9:00am.
